## 12th Annual Health Promotion Project (HPP) – 2024

#### Theme: Harmony in Healthcare: A Culture of Patient Safety

The 12th HPP Exhibition was the largest yet, bringing together over 550 first-year medical students to explore patient safety and preventive medicine. Organized by the Family & Community Medicine Department, the event featured 50 student-led interactive booths on topics like antimicrobial stewardship, AI in healthcare, and 3D bioprinting.

Held at Alfaisal University, the exhibition welcomed **faculty**, **healthcare professionals**, **families**, **and local high school students**, creating a vibrant, community-focused learning environment. Students competed in four judged categories, presented research-driven projects, and networked with national healthcare leaders.

## **10th Annual HPP Exhibition (2022)**

#### **Theme:** *Primary Health Care Research on the Road to Vision 2030* **Overview:**

Celebrating a decade of the HPP, this year's exhibition focused on the role of research in advancing primary healthcare aligned with Saudi Arabia's Vision 2030. Over 420 students, grouped into 41 teams, explored topics such as sustainability, mental health, social determinants, climate change, and equity. Each group presented a research-informed poster and hosted an interactive booth. The exhibition attracted over 1,500 attendees and featured booths by key

organizations including WAEY, Saudi Society for Genetic Medicine, and special guests like Dr. Mandeep Rai.

# **Theme:** *e-Health: The New Norm, The New Competency* **Overview:**

Returning to in-person education post-pandemic, the 9th HPP focused on the transformative role of technology in healthcare during and after COVID-19. Over 350 students formed 31 groups, each addressing emerging digital health trends. Booths were spread across the entire Alfaisal campus, with interactive components and student club-led booths on BLS and environmental awareness. The event saw more than 1,000 attendees and 15 expert judges across multiple disciplines.

#### **Overview:**

Held during the peak of the COVID-19 pandemic, the 8th HPP was a groundbreaking hybrid event showcasing resilience and innovation. Over 350 students were divided into 13 groups, each exploring various aspects of social determinants of health (SDOH) with a local and global lens. The event featured physical attendance under strict safety measures and global virtual participation via Zoom. More than 500 guests attended in person and 150 online. **Objectives:** 

- Deepen understanding of SDOH and social accountability
- Foster teamwork under pandemic restrictions
- Develop creative solutions to health inequities in crises
